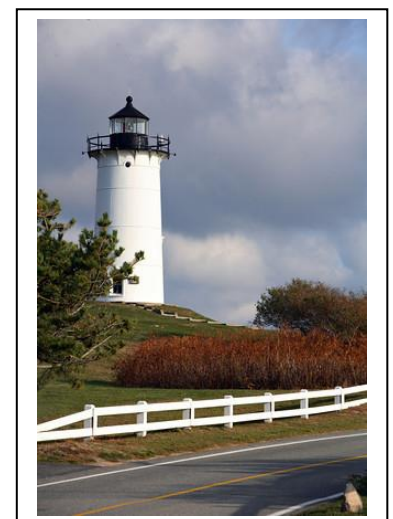

ITINERARY

Day 1: Home City ~ Cape Cod, Massachusetts:

Depart aboard a deluxe highway coach for lovely Cape Cod. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically. Later this afternoon travel to South Yarmouth on Cape Cod for a delightful four-night stay at a beachfront hotel. Over the years Cape Cod has evoked images of weathered-shingled cottages, sea grass-sprayed dunes, and quaint seaside villages! Gather this evening for dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight Cape Cod. Our hotel is located right next to the ocean!

Day 2: Hyannis ~ JFK Memorial ~ Cape Cod National Seashore ~ Provincetown: Today we explore the length of Cape Cod to Provincetown. Begin in Hyannis and see St. Francis Xavier Church, attended by the Kennedy family, the Kennedy Memorial and Hyannisport. Travel down Old King's Highway past cranberry bogs, golden salt marshes and panoramic views of Cape Cod Bay. Continue along Cape Cod National Seashore to Provincetown located at the tip of Cape Cod. Provincetown was the first landing place of the Pilgrims. Today it is a bustling artists' haven filled with a variety of curiosity shops and boutiques. There will be time for lunch and shopping on your own in the downtown area. Later this afternoon we head back to South Yarmouth for dinner and overnight.

Day 3: Cape Cod ~ Plymouth Rock ~ Plimoth Patuxet ~ Resort at leisure: Today we journey to Plymouth and view the famous Plymouth Rock. Enjoy free time to explore Plimoth Patuxet, a complete re-created 17-century Pilgrim village which brings to life the history of first Plymouth Colony and Indigenous homeland. Major exhibits include the 17th-Century English Village, Mayflower II and Plimoth Grist Mill. Later this afternoon we return to our resort and enjoy the balance of the day at leisure.

Day 4: Cape Cod ~ Martha's Vineyard

This morning we board a ferry and sail to the charming island of Martha's Vineyard. As with Nantucket, Martha's Vineyard was an early whaling village. Edgartown is the island's oldest European settlement. Continue onto Oak Bluffs which features carpenter gothic cottages and a quaint shopping district. Uncover local treasures in independent eclectic shops. Walk along the beaches that have made this island a popular resort area. Later today we return to South Yarmouth for dinner and final overnight.

Day 5: Cape Cod ~ Journey Home: This morning we begin our journey home. Rest and meal stops will be made en route. An evening arrival is expected with fond memories of seeing New England in style!
