ITINERARY

Day 1: Cleveland ~ Albany, New York

Travel aboard a deluxe highway motorcoach to the Albany area for the first overnight. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically. Tonight, enjoy a “welcome-to-the-tour” dinner at our hotel.

Day 2: Albany ~ Boston ~ Plymouth ~ Hyannis, Cape Cod

This morning following breakfast we travel to Boston, Massachusetts – the “Cradle of Liberty”. Enjoy a guided sightseeing tour of this historical and fascinating city. Follow the Freedom Trail of Paul Revere and see Bunker Hill Monument, U.S.S. Constitution, Faneuil Hall, Old North Church and Back Bay. Enjoy a stop at JFK Library and Museum. Afterwards, travel to Plymouth Rock and see the Mayflower II. Later this afternoon travel to Hyannis on Cape Cod for a delightful three-night stay. Ah, Cape Cod! The very words evoke images of weathered - shingled cottages, sea grass-sprayed dunes and wind chiseled sea captains, all waiting to enchant you! Overnight Cape Cod.

Day 3: JFK Memorial ~ Cape Cod National Seashore ~ Provincetown ~ Chatham

Following breakfast we explore the length of Cape Cod to Provincetown. Begin in Hyannis and see St. Francis Xavier Church, (attended by the Kennedy family), the Kennedy Memorial and Hyannisport. Travel down the Old King’s Highway past cranberry bogs, golden salt marshes and panoramic views of Cape Cod Bay. Continue along Cape Cod National Seashore to Provincetown located at the tip of Cape Cod. Provincetown was the first landing place of the Pilgrims. Today it is a bustling artists’ haven filled with a variety of curiosity shops and boutiques. There will be time for lunch and shopping on your own in the downtown area. Later this afternoon we head back inland and stop at the lovely seaside village of Chatham. Overnight in Cape Cod.

Day 4: Cape Cod ~ Martha’s Vineyard

This morning we board a ferry and sail to the charming island of Martha’s Vineyard. As with Nantucket, Martha’s Vineyard was an early whaling village. Edgartown is the island’s oldest European settlement. Continue on to Oak Bluffs which features carpenter gothic cottages and a quaint shopping district. Uncover local treasures in independent eclectic shops. Walk along the beaches that have made this island a popular resort area. Later today we return to Hyannis for dinner. Overnight Cape Cod.

Day 5: Cape Cod ~ Newport, Rhode Island ~ Foxwoods Casino

Today, leave Cape Cod and head for beautiful Newport, Rhode Island, one of New England’s most famous ports. Newport is known for its opulent resort section of magnificent estates. Drive along the spectacular Ten Mile Drive to view the summer playground of our country’s first millionaires. Visit one of Newport’s most splendid mansions, the Breakers - summer house of Cornelius Vanderbilt. Enjoy lunch on your own in the brick marketplace of Newport’s harbor before continuing to Connecticut. Enjoy the evening at Foxwoods Casino. A special dinner is included this evening. Overnight Connecticut.

Day 6: Foxwoods ~ Mystic Seaport ~ Poconos

Breakfast included. This morning we visit the Mystic Seaport Museum, a fascinating complex which features historic homes, shops, and trade buildings that promote an understanding of life in a seaport in the 1800’s. More than 100 ships and boats are on display. Later this afternoon enjoy a scenic ride into the Pocono Mountain region of Pennsylvania. Gather this evening for a special “farewell” dinner. Overnight in the Poconos.

Day 7: Poconos ~ Journey Home - Cleveland

Following breakfast we depart the Poconos for a scenic journey back to Ohio. Rest and meals stops will be made periodically. An early evening arrival is expected with fond memories of seeing New England in style!
