

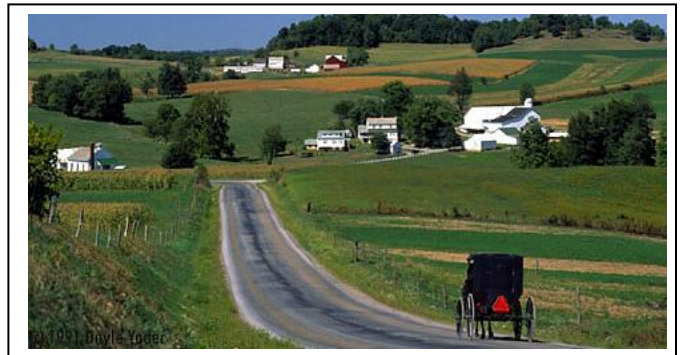

## ITINERARY

**Day 1: Home City ~ Laurel Highlands ~ Fallingwater ~ Historic Gettysburg:** Depart aboard a deluxe highway coach for Gettysburg, PA. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically. Enjoy a stop in the heart of the lovely Laurel Highlands area of Pennsylvania to Fallingwater. Fallingwater, one of Frank Lloyd Wright's most widely acclaimed works, was designed in 1935 for the family of Pittsburgh department store owner Edgar J. Kaufmann. The key to the setting of the house is the waterfall over which it is built. Following a lunch break journey east to historic Gettysburg for dinner and overnight.

**Day 2: Visitor Center & Museum ~ Battlefield Tour ~ Jennie Wade House ~ Lancaster:** Following breakfast we visit the Gettysburg National Visitor Center & Museum. The facility houses one of the world's largest American Civil War collections with over 38,000 artifacts and 350,000 printed documents and photographs. Later this morning we embark on a guided tour of the Gettysburg Battlefield, where one of the most important and hotly contested battles of the Civil War was fought July 1-3, 1863. Throughout the park there are over 1,300 monuments, statues and markers, three observation towers and 31 miles of marked avenues. Additional highlights include Gettysburg National Cemetery, Eternal Light Peace Memorial and Devil's Den. Enjoy free time for lunch, shopping and sightseeing in downtown Gettysburg. This afternoon we visit the Jennie Wade House, home to the only resident who perished during the Gettysburg Battle. Later today we travel east to Lancaster County for a two-night stay.

**Day 3: Lititz ~ Sturgis Pretzel Bakery ~ Wilbur's Chocolate ~ Sight & Sound's MOSES:** This morning we travel to the quaint town of Lititz, dedicated in 1756 as a Moravian community. Visit the Julius Sturgis Pretzel Bakery, the first pretzel bakery in the United States and Wilbur's Chocolate, a long-standing establishment in Lancaster County. Enjoy free time for lunch and shopping on own along historic East Main Street. Later today enjoy reserved seating at the beautiful Sight & Sound Millennium Theatre for the production, MOSES. The parting of the Red Sea...the Burning Bush...the Plagues...the Ten Commandments...finally...the greatest Biblical epic of the Old Testament comes to life on the Sight & Sound stage! Journey back through time and relive the golden splendor and pride of ancient Egypt, the poverty and oppression of the Hebrew slaves and the humble, broken man that God raised up to become their deliverer. Following the show gather for a delicious Amish-style dinner at a local restaurant. Overnight in Lancaster.

**Day 4: Lancaster County ~ Journey Home:** Today we leave eastern Pennsylvania and begin our journey home. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically.
