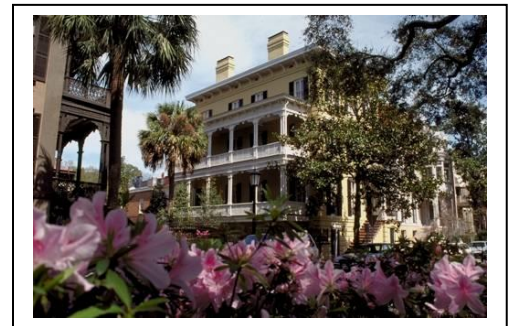

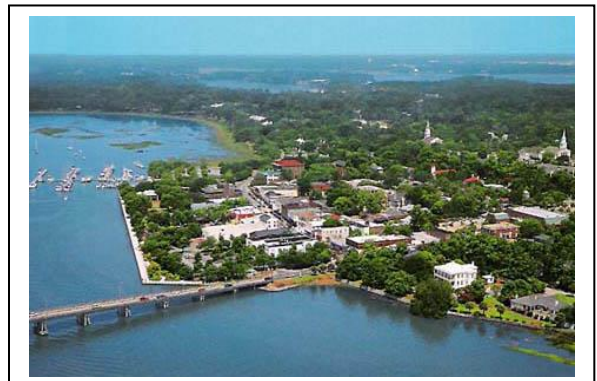

**Day 1: Home City ~ Wytheville, Virginia:**

Travel aboard a deluxe highway touring motorcoach through Pennsylvania, West Virginia, and into Virginia for the first night in Wytheville. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically. Gather this evening for dinner at a local restaurant.

**Day 2: Wytheville ~ Savannah, Georgia ~ Historic District:**

After breakfast we motor south to the Atlantic coast and on to Savannah, Georgia. Rich in cultural history, Savannah features elegant architecture, rare antiques and majestic gardens. A special included dinner is planned for this evening. Enjoy a two-night stay in the historic district of Savannah, located within walking distance to the bustling riverfront area.

**Day 3: Savannah Sights ~ Savannah Riverboat Cruise ~ Savannah at Leisure:**

Breakfast included. Enjoy a delightful city tour of the downtown area featuring many colorful town squares which were originally designed by General James Oglethorpe. A stop will be made at the beautiful Cathedral of Saint John the Baptist. Following a lunch break embark on a delightful riverboat cruise along the Savannah River. The balance of the day is free to enjoy Savannah on your own – shopping or sightseeing along the beautiful riverfront.

**Day 4: Savannah ~ Beaufort, South Carolina ~ Charleston, South Carolina:**

Breakfast included. Today we travel to Beaufort, South Carolina, known as the Queen of the Carolina Sea Islands. Striking mansions and colorful scenery serve as a backdrop for several major motion pictures (Forest Gump, etc.) Later we arrive in Charleston, South Carolina, one of the true gem cities in the heart of the confederacy. Dinner included this evening. Enjoy the next two nights in Charleston area.

**Day 5: Charleston Sights ~ Harbor Cruise:**

After breakfast we embark on a guided tour of Charleston. This lovely 300-year-old city is known for its splendid architecture. From the stately antebellum houses to the more utilitarian single homes that shoulder the narrow streets, Charleston delights the eye. This afternoon following a lunch break enjoy a narrated harbor cruise aboard the paddle-wheeler, *Charleston Harbor Queen*. Highlights include Fort Sumter and the lovely homes that line Charleston's waterfront. Enjoy the evening at leisure to explore Charleston's historic district.

**Day 6: Charleston ~ Magnolia Plantation & Gardens ~ Elkin, North Carolina:**

After breakfast we visit Magnolia Plantation and Gardens. This lovely plantation features one of the largest collections of camellias and azaleas in America. Later today we leave the Charleston area and travel north into North Carolina for the final overnight in Elkin.

**Day 7: North Carolina ~ Home City:**

This morning we leave North Carolina and begin our final journey home. Rest and meal stops will be made periodically. Early evening return home.
